1. 6 lectures each year on topics of local interest. Currently these are held at the Town Hall, Market Place, Newbury on Friday afternoons. From Autumn 2009 it is proposed to hold additional evening lectures.
2. Option to join "study groups" researching particular aspects of the history of the area. These groups meet at times to suit their members. Currently no study group is operating, but the committee would support any group of members who wished to pursue research on a local topic.
3. Join our coach excursions to visit historic houses, castles and gardens throughout southern England. Four visits are usually arranged each year, between April and September.
4. Receive a free copy of the '*Transactions*' which contain 5 or 6 articles on local subjects, plus briefer notes and reports of the Club's activities. We aim to publish '*Transactions*' every three years. New members receive a copy of the latest issue when they join the Club.
